Overview of the 15th Biennial Scientific Conference Opening Doors to Inclusion Across the Lifespan

The ACOT conference 2021 under the theme Opening Doors to Inclusion Across the Lifespan was hosted by the Cayman Islands Occupational Therapy Association (CIOTA) on October 30th 2021. The conference was following a virtual format due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.

As per revealed in the conference program, participants were able to attend 14 interactive sessions within the paediatric, adult & lifespan and professional tracks, in addition to one presentation from the keynote speaker and one presentation from a guest speaker. There were also 8 poster presentations, 7 ACOT country posters, and more. Online *Break Rooms* were also available for participants and presenters to discuss, and exchange. One major highlight is that the conference content and presentations are also available to all attendees for 30 days after the conference.
